


## Support for HPV Vaccine Programs in LICs and LMICs increased by 61.5% in 2019.

- Increase in Gavi funding for HPV Vaccine programs
- Increase in Gavi country cofinancing


**Support for HPV Vaccine Programs in LICs and LMICs** totaled \$65.1 million in 2019.

Support for Cervical Cancer Screen-and-Treat in LICs and LMICs increased by 148.7% in 2019.


- Increase in PEPFAR financing (Go Further program scale-up)


